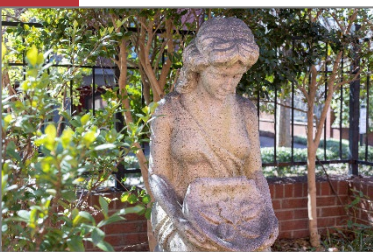


MORNING Waterworks Visual Arts Center

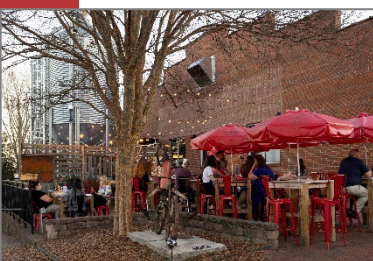


BONUS Shug's at Brooklyn South Square & New Sarum

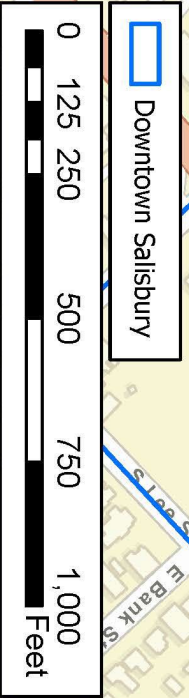
