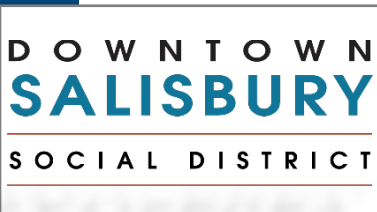


## **DINNER** Jasmine's Creole Kitchen

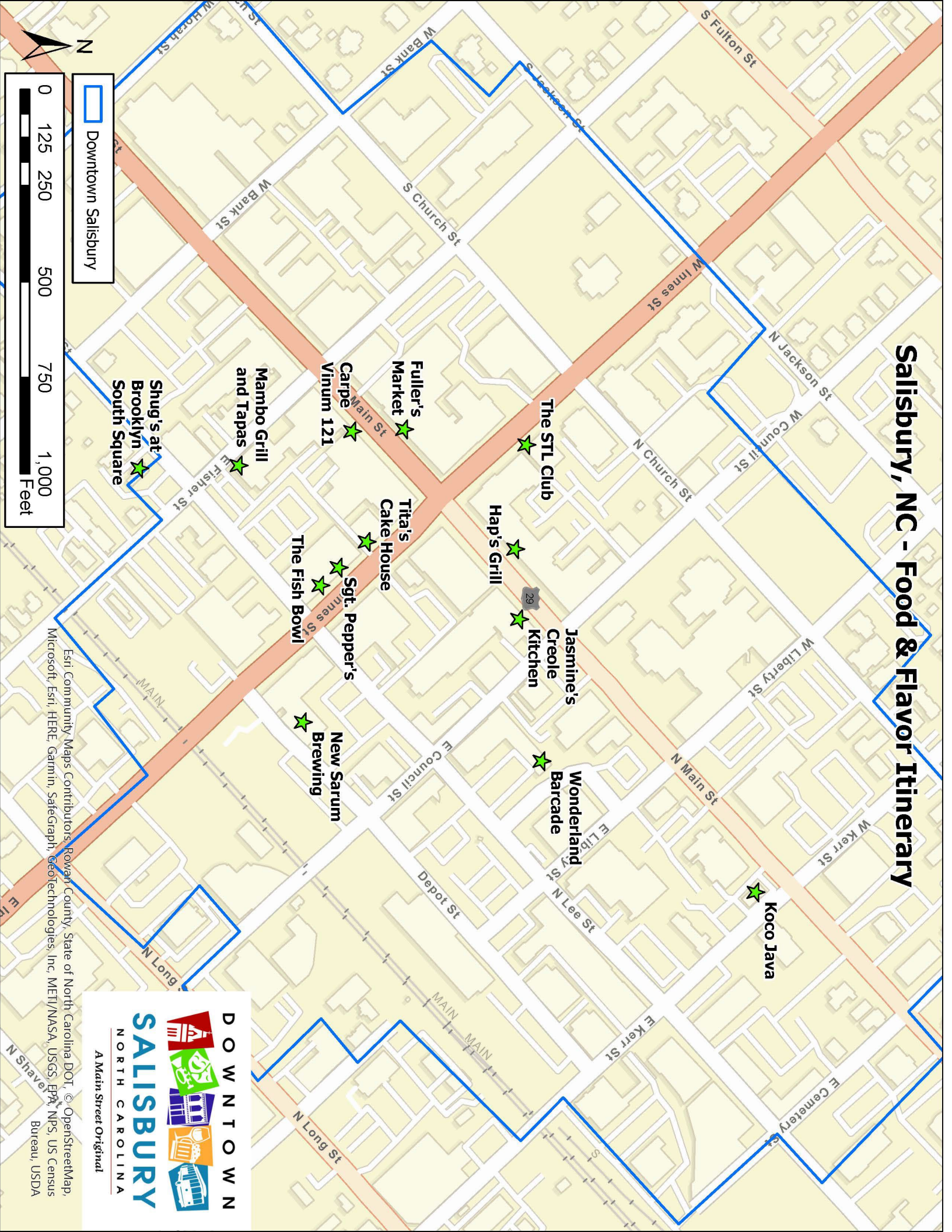




