

- When is the event?
 - Saturday, October 5, 2023, from 12-7.
- What is Wine About Winter/BREWFEST
 - Celebrate the art of craft beer and our buzzing downtown shops, boutiques, and restaurants. This ticketed event will allow attendees 21 years of age or older to experience the diverse flavors offered by craft breweries from all over North Carolina.
- What is the exact location?
 - Bell Tower Green, 120 S. Church St.
- How does the event work?
 - All ticket holders must check in at one of the two tents at Bell Tower Green.
 - Upon checking in ticket holders will receive their tasting cup, souvenir, tote bag, wristband, and list of breweries.
 - Ticket holders are allowed to sample a 4oz pour and unlimited samples.
 - No wristband or cup = NO BEER.
- Can I check in at the venue?
 - Doors open at noon, brewers will serve at noon.
 - Attendees will be able to purchase tickets until 6 p.m.
 - Check-in will close at 6:00 p.m.
- What are the parking arrangements and directions?
 - Attendees can park on the street, around the park (if streets aren't closed), or in the following parking lots:
 - County Lots on N. Main and Kerr St.
 - The back of City Hall, 217 S. Main
 - Parking lot behind the Visitors Center, 204 E. Innes St.
 - The City lot behind Barnhardt Jewelers, 112 E. Innes St.
 - Parking lot on Lee St., across from Salty Caper
 - Wells Fargo lot on W. Fisher St.
- How do I pay for tickets?

- How much are the tickets?
 - Tickets for BREWFEST are \$38 in advance and \$42 the day of.



- Are there any age restrictions for registration?
 - All attendees who plan to participate in the event must be 21+ years of age.
 - All participants must have a valid photo ID.
- Can I pick up tickets for my friends?
 - You <u>may not</u> pick up tickets for anyone else. Each ticket holder must be present to show their ID before picking up items.
- If I purchased tickets and my friend(s), family member, etc. can't attend, what can I do?
 - You can sell or give the ticket to someone else as long as the individual is 21+ years of age.
 - Please be sure the ticket holder is not a scammer.
 - Contact the Downtown Salisbury, Inc. office to confirm the ticket holder is real.
 - There are no refunds.
- · Are there any organized shuttles?
 - No transportation is provided during Bell Tower BREWFEST.
- Does the Social District apply?
 - The social district is NOT in EFFECT during the event.
- What is the dress code?
 - The event is held in the fall, we recommend that attendees dress comfortably.
- What food will be served at the event?
 - There will be various food truck vendors on site serving savory and sweet food.
- Can my spouses and children attend too?
 - Spouses and children are welcome, however, in order to participate in the sampling, participants must be 21+ years of age and have a valid driver's license.
- What happens if the event is canceled due to weather conditions?
 - The event is rain or shine and no refunds. In the event of extreme weather conditions, staff will contact ticket holders via email and post on social media.
